Dear Parents and Guardians,

Statewide assessments, as mandated by The State of Ohio, will begin on April 2nd. Students currently enrolled in English 9, English 10, Algebra I, Geometry, Biology, US History and Government will be tested. Any student who has previously taken the End of Course exams has the opportunity to retake all or some of the exams.

Students are required to accumulate 18 points out of a possible 35 points on the end of course tests in order to graduate. Of these 18 points:

- A minimum of 4 points must be earned on the math end-of course tests. *(Students combine the points earned on the Algebra I and Geometry tests to meet this requirement.)*
- A minimum of 4 points must be earned on the ELA end-of-course tests. *(Students combine the points on the English I and English II tests to meet this requirement.)*
- A minimum of 6 points must be earned on the science and social studies end-of-course tests. *(Students combine the points earned on the Biology test, American History and American Government test to meet this requirement.)*

May 7	American History Part 2 and American Government Part
